



**PREMIER OLSEN TO VISIT EYRE PENINSULA  
6 APRIL 2001**

Premier John Olsen will undertake a low key "meet the people" visit on Eyre Peninsula on Wednesday 11th April 2001. The visit has been organised by the Member for Flinders Liz Penfold.

The Premier is scheduled to arrive at Minnipa Research Centre at 10.30am,. He will tour the facility, meet workers and be briefed by farming systems co-ordinator Samantha Doudle.

Then it's on to Wudinna to meet councillors and Council officers prior to a community BBQ lunch at the Wudinna Sports Centre. Members of the public are invited to attend the lunch where Mr Olsen will outline "The State of the State." There will also be an opportunity for the community to raise issues in this open forum.

Later in Port Lincoln, the Premier will visit the recently redeveloped Port Lincoln Hospital and take part in a meeting for the Port Lincoln water Reuse Project.

Ms Penfold says the Premier was keen to accept her invitation to meet with as many people as possible in an informal basis.

"This trip is all about personal contact. The Premier wants to hear about the issues that are concerning our local community", Mrs Penfold said.
